<p>Your organisation Please describe your organisation and your areas of activity.</p>	<p>Smoleničan is a civic association that was established to support and develop cultural values. The association was founded in 2015 and we mainly organize cultural and open social events. We have organized five successful cultural events which took place mainly at Smolenice Castle and in the natural amphitheatre (in Slovakia). The members of the association are also co-organizers of the event.</p>
<p>Project idea Please give a brief description of your project idea, what you want to achieve and how you plan to achieve it.</p>	<p>We are a community with a background in culture and the arts, which has enthusiastically decided to create an event which would artistically and culturally enrich the life of all ages.</p> <p>The aim of the project is to organize a family festival called “Čarohry” that combines an interactive theatrical performance for children with activities for children and adults in the accompanying all-day program. The festival will take place during two weekend days, always at a different Slovak castle or chateau, in different regions of Slovakia. The main part of the festival is the original Slovak fairy tale inspired Celtic mythology, which will be played twice a day.</p> <p>Our intention is to revive the locks that would open through the themes of the fairy tale the world of fantasy not only to the child but</p>

	also to an adult. Thanks to the prepared program, we can target each visitor. The people will be able to make contact with history as well.
