RECOMMENDATIONS FROM NORDIC ARTISTS WITH A MULTICULTURAL BACKGROUND TO LEADERS AND DECISION-MAKERS IN THE NORDIC REGION

We recommend

#1

That people of multicultural backgrounds are part of any decision-making process. An added perspective is needed in leadership positions, in organizations, on boards, in political debates as well as anywhere else.

#2

Data on representation within cultural institutions should be collected and presented. This information ought to be made available for the larger public to engage with.

#3

Art institutions take a critical look at their own narrative and cultural accessibility.

The effort to break down institutionalized exclusion is currently lacking.

#4

Multicultural ambassadors within all art institutions.

#5

A broader media representation. The visibility and voice of multicultural art and artists must have priority.

#6

Stepping out of your comfort zone. Advocate for public and institutional policies that pursue needed systemic change and promote cultural equity and art that reflects the full breadth of Nordic society.
